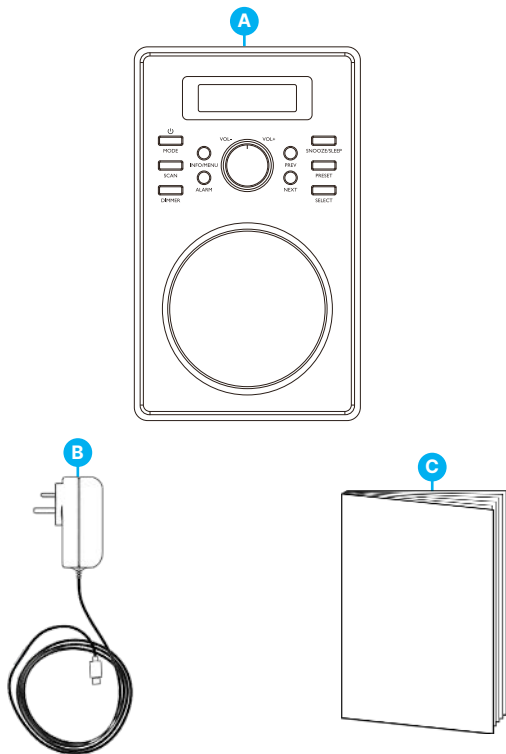

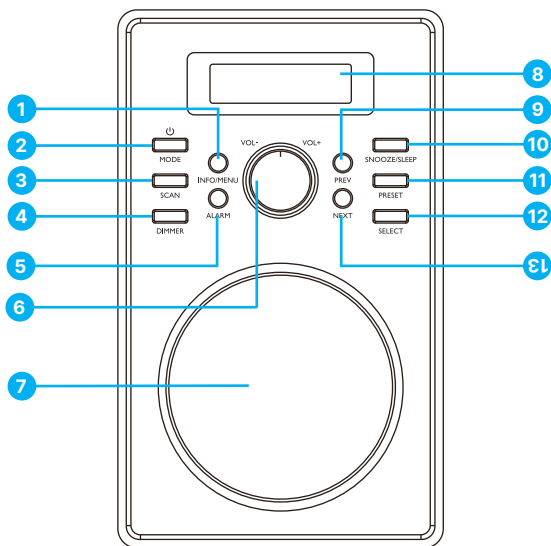

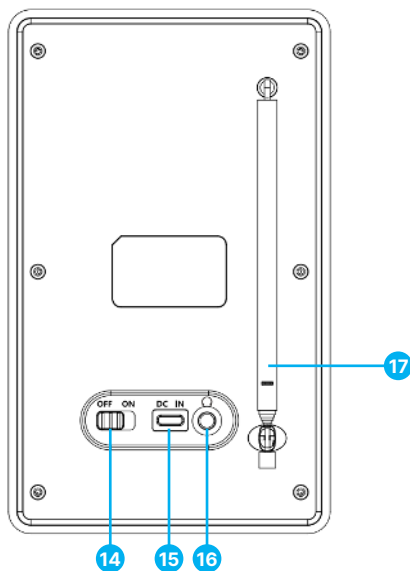


Front View

PLEASE NOTE: All (Ref.) refer to Page 4-5 controls and functions mapping guide.

Product Set-Up

Remove the packaging and prepare the **Oakcastle DAB10** radio for use. Position the radio where you have the best radio signal reception and fully extend the antenna (Ref.17) to ensure the strongest possible signal.

Connect the radio to mains power . Insert the USB Type-C cable end into the port (Ref.15) located at the back of the radio, then connect the plug to a wall socket.

Switch the radio on using the **Radio Power Switch** located at the back of the unit (Ref.14). The screen will display “Welcome to Digital Radio.” Press the **Power, Standby/Mode** button (Ref.2) to begin the setup process.

On first use, you will be asked to select your preferred language. Using the 'PREV or 'NEXT' buttons (Ref.9/13) choose your language from the list and confirm by pressing the **SELECT** button (Ref.12). The radio will then automatically begin scanning for available DAB stations in your area. Once the scan is complete, the radio will start playing the first found DAB station with good signal.

***Please note :** If the radio buttons do not function, it is likely because the selected language was not confirmed by pressing the **SELECT** button (Ref.12). Please complete this step, as it is mandatory during the initial setup.*

Switch the radio ON/OFF

To fully power the radio on or off, use the switch button located at the back of the radio (Ref.14).

Standby Mode

To manually set the Little Shelford into **Standby mode**, press and hold the '**Power, Standby/Mode**' button (Ref.2) for three or four seconds. Press and hold the same button again for three seconds to power on and resume playing.

Radio display brightness

Press the 'Dimmer' button (Ref.4) repeatedly to change display brightness.

The display screen will dim automatically after 10 seconds if left in standby or working mode.

Headphone Jack:

For private listening, you can use wired headphones (not included) with a 3.5 mm jack which can be inserted into its port at the back of the radio (Ref.16).

The **Oakcastle DAB10** offers **40 preset slots** available in each radio mode (FM and DAB). These are referred to as presets and allow you to save your favourite stations for quick access at any time.

Storing Radio Stations in FM or DAB radio mode (Presets)

To save a station to the preset list:

- While the station is playing, press and hold the **Preset** button (**Ref.11**) for two-three **seconds** to open the **Preset Store** list
- The radio display will show a list with the heading **Preset Store**, followed by available preset slots labelled **X: (Empty)** (where "X" represents the slot number).
- Once the list appears, release the '**Preset**' button (**Ref.11**) and use the '**PREV**' or '**NEXT**' buttons (**Ref.9/13**) to scroll through the list. Select an empty preset slot. then press the '**SELECT**' button (**Ref. 12**) to save the station.
- The radio will confirm the action with the message **Preset 'X' Stored**.

Please note:

*If, after selecting a slot, the radio displays **Preset Empty**, it means you are in the Recall Presets list instead of the Store Presets list.*

*To fix this, press and hold the **Preset** button again to re-open the **Store Presets** list.*

*If a station is already saved in a preset slot, it will be **overwritten** when you save a new station to that same slot.*

Recalling a Stored Radio Station in FM or DAB radio mode (Preset)

To recall a saved station:

- Set the radio to FM or DAB mode. The last played station will begin playing automatically.
- Briefly press the '**Preset**' button (**Ref.11**) to open the **Recall Presets** list.
- The radio screen will display the list with all saved stations. Use the '**PREV**' or '**NEXT**' buttons (**Ref.9/13**) to scroll through your saved stations (1–40).
- When the desired station is highlighted, press '**SELECT**' button (**Ref.12**) to begin playing it.

Please note:

If the Recall Presets list shows all slots as empty, you will need to save stations again before using the recall list.

In FM mode, once an automatic scan is completed, the recall list will automatically populate with all stations found.

Fully extend the antenna (**Ref.17**) to ensure the best possible signal reception before scanning, then switch the radio on.

- Press the '**Power, Standby/Mode**' button (**Ref.2**) repeatedly to select **DAB**, then press '**SELECT**' button (**Ref.12**) to enter DAB Radio Mode.
- On first use, the radio will **automatically scan** and save available DAB/DAB+ stations to the **Stations List**. The clock will sync with the broadcasting station.
- To enter and browse the station list, press the **PREV** or **NEXT** buttons (**Ref.9/13**) to scroll through the available stations. Then press the **SELECT** button (**Ref.12**) to confirm your choice and start playing the selected station.
- To **manually scan** or **rescan**: press the '**Scan**' (**Ref.3**). The radio will start processing a new DAB scan and create a new Stations list.
- Alternatively, press and hold the **Info/Menu** button (**Ref.2**) for three seconds to enter the **Set Menu**. Navigate to **Full Scan**, then press the **SELECT** button (**Ref.12**) to start the scan.

Storing & Recalling Radio Stations (Presets)

To store or recall radio stations in DAB Mode, please follow the instructions on page 7.

Station Information for DAB/DAB+ Radio

When listening to a DAB/DAB+ radio station with a good signal, press the **Info/Menu** button (**Ref.1**) repeatedly to cycle through the available programme information.

Signal Strength : showing the radio station signal strength

Signal Error Rate : Indicates the signal error rate.

Bit Rate: Shows the data rate at which the signal is transmitted.

Channel and Frequency: Displays the station's transmission channel number and frequency band.

PTY (Programme Type): Shows the type or description of the programme provided by the DAB station.

Time and Date: Displays the time and date information supplied by the broadcaster.

Dynamic Label Segment (DLS): Shows scrolling text information provided by the broadcaster.

Fully extend the antenna (**Ref.17**) to ensure the best possible signal reception before scanning, then switch the radio on.

- Press the **Power/Standby/Mode** button (**Ref.2**) repeatedly to select **FM**, then press the '**SELECT**' button (**Ref.12**) to enter FM Radio Mode.
- At first use in FM Mode, the radio will display the FM frequency **87.5 MHz** on the screen.
- To scan for available stations with a good signal, press the **Scan** button (**Ref.3**) to begin scanning and saving the FM stations available at your location. Once the automatic scan is completed, the radio will start playing the first found station with a good signal.
- To access the list of stations found and saved during the automatic scan, short press the **Preset** button (**Ref.11**) to open the **Recall Presets** list. Using the '**PREV**' and '**NEXT**' buttons (**Ref.9/13**), go through the list. Select the station you want to play, then press the '**SELECT**' button (**Ref.12**) to start playing.
- To perform a new automatic full scan, press the **Scan** button (**Ref.3**). When processing a new scan, the saved presets will be erased and replaced with the new ones automatically.

Manual scan the FM Radio band

- Before processing a new scan, press and hold the **Info/Menu** button (**Ref.1**) for 2–3 seconds to enter the **Set Menu**. Use the '**PREV**' and '**NEXT**' buttons (**Ref.9/13**) to navigate to **Scan Settings**, then enter to select your scan preference: **Strong Stations Only** or **All Stations**. Choose one of these and confirm by pressing the '**SELECT**' button (**Ref.12**). Process a new scan for radio stations as per your selection.
- To scan down the frequency band, press and hold the '<<' button (**Ref.3**) for two seconds. To scan up the band, press and hold the '>>' button (**Ref.4**).
- To manually fine-tune radio stations or scan up/down the FM band by 0.05 MHz, short press the '<</'>>' buttons (**Ref.3/4**).
- To listen to a specific frequency quickly, press and hold the '>>>' button (**Ref.4**) to search up the bandwidth and hold the '<<<' button (**Ref.3**) to search down.

Stereo and Mono

When in FM mode, press the **Enter/Snooze** button (**Ref.5**) to switch between Stereo and Mono.

Storing & Recalling Radio Stations (Presets)

To store or recall radio stations in FM Mode, please follow the instructions on page 7.

Station Information for FM Radio

When listening to an FM radio station with a good signal, press the **Info/Menu** button (**Ref.8**) repeatedly to view different programme information:

- **PTY (Program Type):** Shows the type and description of the program provided by the FM station.
- **Signal Strength:** Displays a signal bar indicating the strength of the current station.
- **Time and Date:** Displays the current time and date.
- **Frequency:** Displays the station's transmission frequency.
- **Audio Type:** Displays the audio type of the station (Stereo or Mono).
- **Radio Text:** Displays scrolling text information supplied by the broadcaster.

***Please note:** In FM mode, this station information is available only if the FM station you are listening to broadcasts this data.*

Bluetooth Pairing

- The Oakcastle DAB10 Radio can be paired via Bluetooth with devices such as a phone, tablet, or CD player to play audio through the radio speaker.
- Press the '**Power, Standby/Mode**' button (Ref.2) repeatedly to select **Bluetooth**, then press the **SELECT** button (Ref.12) to enter this mode.
- On your Bluetooth device, ensure Bluetooth is enabled. '**Oackcastle DAB10 Radio**' should appear in the list of available devices. Select it to connect.
- Once connected, scrolling text '**BT connected**' will appear on the radio screen. You can now play audio from your device through the radio speaker. Adjust the volume on both the device and the radio as needed.

Radio Buttons in Bluetooth Mode

- Use the **PREV or NEXT** buttons (Ref.9/13) to skip to previous or next audio track.
- Use the **SELECT** button (Ref.12) to pause or resume playback.
- Use the **Volume +/-** on your device, and radio to increase/decrease the volume level.

Unpairing the Radio

- Press and hold the **SELECT** button (Ref.12) for 4 seconds, or
- Remove the device from the paired device list on your Bluetooth device.

Pairing a New Device

- To pair with a new device after disconnecting, repeat the pairing steps.

Reconnecting a Previously Paired Device

- To reconnect with a previously paired device after powering on, enter Bluetooth mode and wait three seconds.

Important Notes

*The **Oackcastle DAB10 radio cannot be paired with Bluetooth earbuds, headphones, or external speakers.***

If no audio is received from the paired device for 15 minutes while in Bluetooth (BT) mode, the radio will automatically switch to Standby mode.

*To exit Standby mode, press and hold the **Power, Standby/Mode** button (Ref.2) for two, three seconds.*

Clock and Date Settings

Setting the Time and Date Automatically

When the radio is set to **DAB Mode** and starts playing a station with strong signal, the time and date are automatically updated. If this does not happen, or if you wish to adjust the time and date manually, follow the steps below:

Setting the Time and Date Manually

- Ensure the unit is in working mode (e.g., listening to DAB/FM Radio, BT).
- Press and hold the **Info/Menu** button (Ref.8) for two seconds to open the 'Set Menu'.
- Use the **PREV** or **NEXT** buttons (Ref. 9/13) to navigate to **Time/Date**, then press **SELECT** button (Ref.12) to enter.
- The **hour will flash**. Use **PREV** or **NEXT** buttons (Ref. 9/13) to adjust the hour, then press **SELECT** button (Ref.12) to confirm.
- Use **PREV** or **NEXT** buttons (Ref. 9/13) to set the minutes, then press **SELECT** button (Ref.12) to confirm.
- The **year will flash**. Use **PREV** or **NEXT** buttons (Ref.9/13) to set the correct year, then press **SELECT** button (Ref.12)
- Repeat the process for the month and date, using << or >> and confirming with **Enter/Snooze**.

Please Note: When the radio is set to DAB Mode the time and date are automatically updated.

Dual Alarm Settings

Setting Alarm 1 or Alarm 2

- Press the '**Alarm**' button (Ref.5) to enter the Alarm Menu. Press once to enter Alarm 1, press again to enter Alarm 2. Alternatively, press and hold the **Info/Menu** button (Ref.1) for two seconds to open the 'Set Menu'. Use **PREV** or **NEXT** buttons (Ref.9/13) to find **Alarm 1 Set** or **Alarm 2 Set**, then press **SELECT** button (Ref.12) to enter the one you are about to set.
- To turn the selected Alarm **ON** or **OFF**, press **PREV** or **NEXT** to select your option then confirm with **SELECT** button (Ref.12). Set the selected Alarm to **ON** to activate the alarm setting.
- Next, set the alarm time using **PREV** or **NEXT** for hours and minutes, confirming each with **SELECT** button (Ref.12).
- Adjust the **alarm volume**, confirm, then set **the alarm ringtone**. You can choose to sound with **Alarm, DAB, or FM**. Confirm your selection with **SELECT** button (Ref.12).

- Set the **Alarm Mode (frequency)**, and choose in between: **Once, Daily, Weekdays or Weekends**. Press the **SELECT** button (Ref.12) to confirm your selection.
- Press **Info/Menu** to return to the previous step at any time, then follow these same steps to set the other alarm.

Turn Off, Cancel or Snooze

Turning Off the Alarm

- When the alarm sounds, press the **Power, Standby/Mode** button (Ref.2) to turn it off. Alternatively, press short the **Alarm** button (Ref.5).
- If the alarm is set to **Weekday, Weekend, or Daily**, the alarm icon will remain on the standby screen for the corresponding day.
- If the alarm is set to **Once**, the alarm icon will disappear after it sounds.

Cancelling an Alarm

- To cancel an alarm, when is not sounding, follow the steps to set the alarm. Instead of selecting the Alarm 1 or Alarm 2 to **ON**, set it to **OFF** using the **PREV or NEXT** buttons (Ref.9/13), press the **SELECT** button to confirm.

Pressing the Snooze Function

- When the alarm sounds, press **Snooze/ Sleep** button (Ref.10), to delay the alarm for 9 minutes. The radio will enter standby mode.
- To stop the snooze alarm or resume normal operation, press the **Power, Standby/Mode** button (Ref.1).

Please note:

When the alarm sounds, if no action is taken, it can last for up to one hour.

*If the alarm ringtone is set to **DAB** or **FM**, the radio will play the last played station in that mode.*

If the DAB or FM station has a weak signal, the alarm will default to the standard alarm ringtone instead of the radio station.

Settings: Sleep Timer

Ensure the unit is in working mode (i.e., listening to DAB/FM Radio ,BT).

- Press the **Snooze/Sleep** button (**Ref.10**) to enter Sleep Timer Menu.
- The screen will display '**Set Sleep: OFF**'. Use the **PREV** or **NEXT** buttons (**Ref.9/13**) to browse through the sleep timer options: 120, 90, 60, 45, 30, 15, 5 minutes, or OFF.
- Select your desired time frame from the options available. When this is displayed, press **the SELECT** button (**Ref.12**) to confirm and activate the sleep timer. The system will automatically start counting down.
- Once the timer is set, the remaining minutes will count down on the display. For example, if set for 5 minutes, '**S5**' will flash and countdown to '**S0**', at which point the radio will enter Standby mode.
- To turn the sleep timer off, repeat the above steps and select **OFF**.
- The Sleep Timer can also be set via Radio Menu.. Press and hold the **Info/Menu** button (**Ref.1**) for two seconds to open the **Set Menu**. Using the **PREV** or **NEXT** buttons search through the menu to find **Sleep Set Menu**.

Radio – ‘Set Menu’

- The Oakcastle DAB10 Radio **Set Menu** settings can be accessed in DAB, FM or Bluetooth mode.
- While in working mode (powered on), press and hold the **Info/Menu** button (Ref. 1) for two-three seconds to enter the **Set Menu**.
- Use the **PREV** and **NEXT** buttons (Ref.9/13) to scroll through the available options: **Time/Date**, **System Version**, **Factory Reset**, **Alarm 1 Set**, **Alarm 2 Set**, **Sleep Set**, **Full Scan** (available only in DAB mode), **Scan Setting** (available only in FM mode), and **Language**. Select an option by pressing the **SELECT** button (Ref. 12).

Time/Date, **Alarm 1 Set**, **Alarm 2 Set**, and **Sleep Set** are detailed on pages 11–13.

System Version

- Enter to view the radio's software version.

Factory Reset

- Select to perform a factory reset to resolve functionality issues.
- Choose **YES** to confirm with **SELECT** button (Ref.12), or **NO** to cancel.

Please note: A factory reset will restore the radio to its default settings and erase all saved settings. Once completed, you will need to add them again.

Language

- Enter to change the radio menu language.
- Select from **English**, **German**, **French**, **Italian**, **Spanish**, then confirm with **SELECT** button (Ref.12).

Observation	Potential Cause/Solution
No sound	The station is not tuned in properly. Please perform a rescan for available stations or manually scroll through available stations. Process a factory reset of the radio (view page 14)
Cannot preset stations	While playing the station you want to save, press and hold the Preset button for 2–3 seconds to open the Preset Store settings. If the list that appears does not show “ Preset Store ” at the top, press and hold the Preset button again to enter the store menu. Select a slot and press Enter to confirm.
FM: Static sound DAB: Burbling/intermittent cut-out	Signal reception is low. Adjust the aerial or move the unit to a stronger signal location. Perform a rescan. Re-scan stations and/or a factory reset.
Cannot locate DAB/DAB+ mode	FM mode is indicated by “FM” and the station frequency. DAB mode does not display “DAB+” on the screen. Instead, the first available DAB station name will display.
Desired station not found	Weak signal. Use the manual tune function and try rescanning in a different area.
Display shows “No Service”	There is no DAB coverage in your area, or poor reception. Adjust the position of the aerial, or move the unit to a stronger signal location.
Display is blank	This may occur if the broadcaster changes the label of a service or removes a label while tuned. The radio will try to retune or perform a scan.
Time and Date not setting automatically	To automatically set the time and date, turn on the system and switch to DAB radio. Alternatively, you can edit these in radio settings.

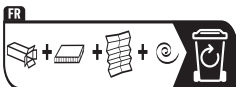
